Dear Parents and students,

Greetings!

Without our students the school was just a building. Heart and soul to this structure is added by our students. Smiling faces, bright eyes, ringing voices make the whole building alive. They make it vibrate with thoughts and energy. We at TCS missed our students and are really glad to have them back with us. It gives me immense pleasure to welcome you all back to school and a new academic session 2020-21.

As per the Ministry of Education & Higher Education guidelines and safety regulations, TCS reopened for the new academic on 1st Sept 2020. Until further guidelines from the Ministry, for Term 1 Teaching /Learning will be a blend of Classroom lessons and Remote lessons.

I would like to update the parents of the following

1. The students will be coming to school twice a week on the days stipulated for them.
2. The details of the days each child needs to come to school has been uploaded on the portal.
3. In addition, the students have also been issued colour coded cards with days mentioned, to facilitate parents in this.
4. The school will have normal teaching learning during these days with a short staggered break to maintain social distancing.
5. Detailed Timetable to be followed has been uploaded on the portal and also shared with the students in school.
6. Groups once allotted will not be changed as the school needs to follow the Ministry norms of daily attendance.
7. All homework will be assigned through School portal.
8. Assessments like CAS, QUIZ will be conducted online while Term End Exams, will be conducted in the School, as per preannounced schedule.
9. Attendance is compulsory for assessments.
10. All students must bring **their own** food, water, hand sanitisers and spare face masks. Sharing of food is not permitted in school premises.
11. School Canteen will remain closed and water dispensers and vending machines will not be available in the school buildings. Parents **should ensure** students bring **sufficient water and food** for their whole day in school as a safety measure.
12. Students must also bring the stationery required for their daily use as sharing of these items is strictly prohibited.

The past year has been tough and we have all been struggling to keep pace but remember that no matter how hard the past is, you can always begin again. We will be able to do so only with support from you. May all are parents and students stay safe and healthy. I appreciate the efforts put in by all associated with TCS for making it the school that it is.


